FROM HOMELESS TO HOPEFUL

Alyson's world was turned upside down the minute she was placed in a mental health hold at a local hospital in Madera. She was allowed to return home after several weeks. However, there was no home for her to return to. Alyson was both a minor and homeless. The hospital had to release her to an emergency shelter for adolescents experiencing homelessness.

Alyson left the shelter on her own after turning 18. She began sleeping in a tent at Roeding Park. She shared that she was quickly taken advantage of after leaving the shelter. The environment of the streets exposed her to many temptations. She used drugs and alcohol to numb herself to ease her depression. Alyson did not want that for herself. She did not want to fall into addiction. She knew she needed to keep moving forward.

The HOPE Outreach Team found Alyson while she was sleeping in Roeding Park. They began working with her to secure shelter at Poverello House. She was accepted into the Village of Hope. Her Navigator would be Mercedes Maldonado. A Navigator is a person who walks alongside those transitioning out of homelessness. Mercedes went above and beyond for Alyson. She even drove to Madera to receive Alyson's birth certificate and social security card from her father! The courts mandated that Alyson move from Missouri to California with her father when she was just 12 years old. She lost contact with her mother and sister in Kansas City.

Alyson decided to download Facebook and reach out to her mom while at the Village of Hope. Her mom told her that she had been waiting for Alyson to come home. Her mom booked a flight to California right away. Alyson was reunited with her mom. Alyson walked across the stage and received her high school diploma on June 1st. She would fly back home with her mother on June 4th! She is already enrolled in a cosmetology school in Kansas. Alyson's journey is just beginning. Poverello House is honored to be part of her journey. We look forward to all that Alyson will achieve in her future endeavors!
